
	CURRENT SITUATION
Current	As of this morning at 8:00 a.m., The Los Angeles City Fire Department, The Los Angeles County Fire
Situation:	Department, and Angeles National Forest returned to their respective jurisdictions to continue firefighting efforts.
	Firefighters continue to negotiate rugged terrain to increase containment lines and address hot spots. Tactical patrols will remain in place to monitor the area for smoldering debris. Low humidity and gusty northerly winds are expected again this evening and "Red Flag Warning" is in effect until 10:00 p.m. on Sunday.
	The public is reminded to please drive cautiously and yield to emergency personnel working in and around the burn area.
	The cause of the Saddle Ridge Fire remains under active investigation.
