CURRENT SITUATION				
Situation Summary:	Currently, 176 firefighters remain on-scene with additional resources available should further need arise. Firefighters continue to patrol the fire lines performing spot checks throughout the burned areas to prevent any chance of rekindle with a change in the weather. Incident objectives focus on further advancing the containment lines. Until this fire is 100% contained, increasing fire behavior is always a potential risk. In the event of a new ignition, very rapid fire read, long range spotting, and extreme fire behavior due to record low fuel moisture is possible. Forecasted Santa Ana winds have the potential to test containment lines.
