## CURRENT SITUATION

<b>Situation Summary:</b>	The combination of hot temperatures, low relative humidities, locally gusty winds, and drying fuels brought elevated fire weather conditions to the Soledad Fire burn area today. Crews made progress today extinguishing hot spots along with building and reinforcing containment lines. One Firefighter suffered a minor injury while working on the fire line. Crews will work through the night scouting for any potential flare ups, mopping up hot spots and holding containment lines.
<b>Evacuations:</b>	All evacuation orders have been lifted as of 2 P.M. today. Approximately 9 homes with 40 residents were repopulated today.
