## **CURRENT SITUATION**

Current Situation: Santa Ana winds will diminish through the day with weak onshore winds possible this afternoon along the coast. Firefighting resources will pursue opportunities to build and improve direct line to minimize further perimeter growth and support containment objectives. Fire suppression repair teams are actively engaged working around the fire perimeter and affected areas.

†Preliminary estimates show 483 total structures destroyed which accounts for nonresidential commercial property and minor structures. However, damage assessment for the affected area is 22% complete showing 279 confirmed structures destroyed and 86 structures damaged.
