Current Situation:

Firefighting resources will continue to mop up and patrol. Crews remain diligent in providing public service to residents as they return to their homes. Structures destroyed and damaged have been validated by damage assessment teams. 100% of the burn assessment is complete. Unified Command will prepare for potential rain and have a contingency plan for mud and debris flow.
