CURRENT SITUATION

Situation Summary:	At approximately 3:28 p.m. yesterday evening a wind driven brush fire started at the intersection of Soledad Canyon Road and the 14 Fwy. Warm weather and gusty 20-30mph winds drove the fire to approximately 1,100 acres. The head of fire slowed overnight with increased relative humidity and lower temps. There is still potential fire growth as temperatures warm throughout the day where fuel and topography align. Crews will work through the day mopping up hot spots, protecting structures and building containment lines.
Evacuations:	Approximately 9 homes with 40 residents are currently under evacuation order.
Temporary Evacuation Point(s):	Victory Outreach 37419 25th Street E Palmdale, CA 93550 Clients and small animals can relocate to the temporary evacuation point where individual needs will be assess by Red Cross personnel.
Road Closures:	N/B SR-14 just North of Soledad Canyon Road. #3 & 4 Lanes and Soledad Canyon On-Ramp and Agua Dulce Off Ramp will be blocked for an unknown duration.
