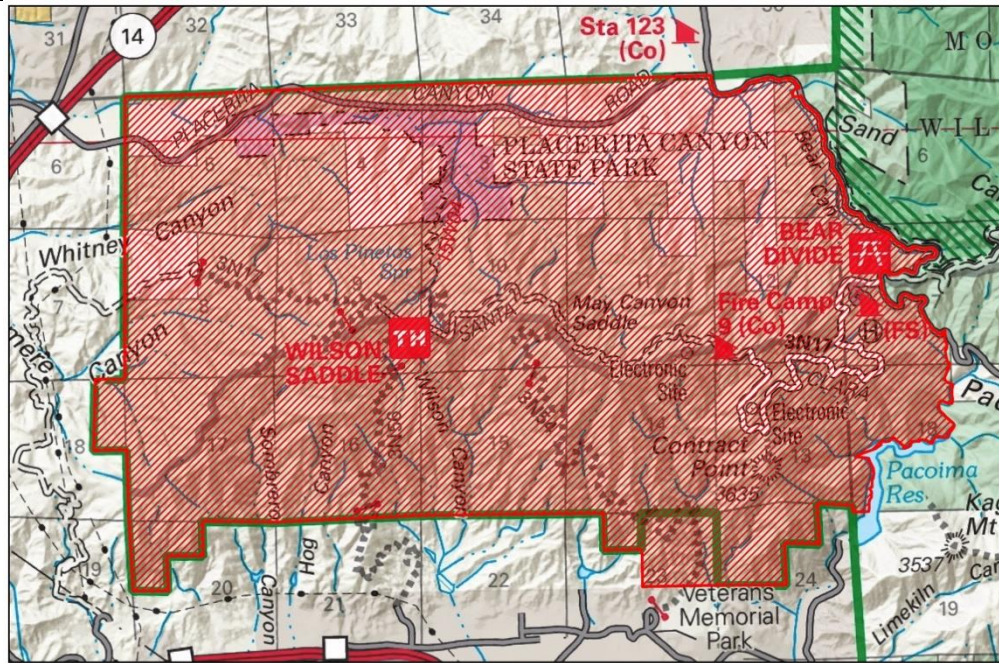

CURRENT SITUATION	
Current Situation:	<p>Firefighters will work through the day in rugged terrain throughout the burn area to increase containment lines. Tactical patrols will remain in place to monitor the area for smoldering debris. Crews will take advantage of the conditions to make progress and bolster containment lines.</p> <p>We ask that everyone driving in the area remain cautious of emergency personnel.</p> <p>The cause of the Saddle Ridge Fire remains under active investigation.</p>
