Current Situation:	Winds continue across the San Gabriel Mountain Range and Creek Fire area.			
	Perimeter line will continue to be constructed, as well as improved around critical infrastructure.			
	The Angeles National Forest has elevated its fire danger level to EXTREME. Fire restrictions are now in effect throughout the Forest to include: NO CAMPFIRES, NO OPEN FLAME, NO BBQ's or GRILLING. Further restrictions could include restricted use of recreation areas.
