

LOS ANGELES COUNTY FIRE DEPARTMENT PAY RATE FOR FSA'S AND FSO'S

THE FOLLOWING PAY GUIDELINES ARE CURRENT AS OF MAY 1, 2006

FIRE SAFETY ADVISORS (FSA)

Rate is \$40.00 per hour, four (4) hour minimum. Time and a half applies after eight (8) hours; double time applies after 12 hours. Holiday and weekends are the same with meals included and FSA's are paid for by the production company.

1. All call for a minimum of four (4) hours, time and a half applies after eight (8) hours and double time after 12 hours.
2. Once an FSA has been assigned to production, that Production Company is responsible for the four (4) hour minimum fee, unless the production company notifies the County of Los Angeles Fire Department prior to 5 p.m. on the last work day prior to the production call.
3. Hours worked shall be continuous from call time to wrap, no split shifts and no deductions for meal times are allowed.
4. FSA's shall be included in meals at no cost.
5. FSA's are former County of Los Angeles Fire Department employees and are not covered by the Los Angeles County Fire Department Workers Compensation Insurance.

THE FOLLOWING PAY GUIDELINES ARE CURRENT AS OF JANUARY 1, 2011

FIRE SAFETY OFFICERS (FSO)

Rate is \$133.19 per hour, flat rate. No hour minimum or time and a half.
