

## Red Flag Weather

Generally Red Flag weather conditions exist when winds are blowing in excess of 25 MPH and the humidity is below 15%.

On these days there are precautions you can take:

- Park car heading out, windows closed
- Disconnect garage door openers; use manual mode
- Place your important items in your car – papers, etc.
- Keep pet carriers handy
- Before you go: Open drapes or window coverings  
Keep windows closed, close interior doors  
Turn on all the lights
