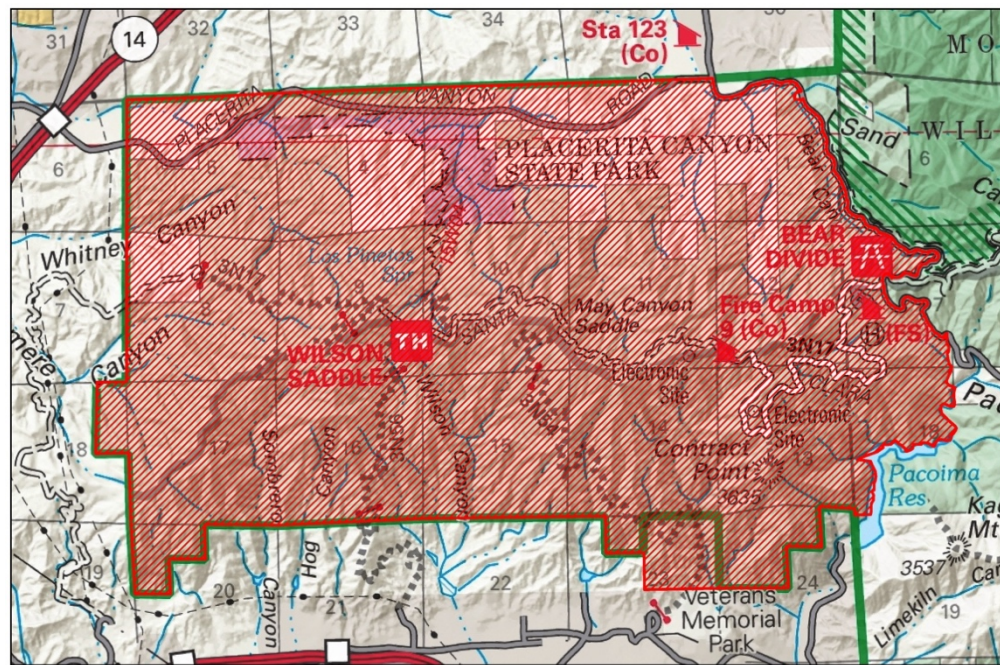

Current Situation:	<p>Firefighters from The Los Angeles City Fire Department, The Los Angeles County Fire Department, and Angeles National Forest continue to work in their respective jurisdictions with support from assisting agencies to increase containment lines and address hot spots.</p> <p>Tactical patrols will remain in place to monitor the area as low humidity and gusty northerly winds are still a concern. The "Red Flag Warning" is in effect until 10:00 p.m. this evening.</p> <p>The public is reminded to please drive cautiously and yield to emergency personnel working in and around the burn area.</p> <p>The cause of the Saddle Ridge Fire remains under active investigation.</p>
