| Current Situation: | This fire is being fueled by a high pressure santa ana wind coming out of the northeast with sustained wind speeds of 20-30 mph gusting to approximately 60 mph in passes and canyons. High winds, low relative humidity and warm temperatures are contributing to extreme fire behavior. Extremely dry fuels exposed to ember cast are exhibiting a high potential for spot fires creating a significant concern for Firefighter safety. As resources continue to pour into the area residents are encouraged to maintain high state of situational awareness and monitor local media for updated evacuation orders. This is an extremely dangerous fire, early compliance with evacuation orders is essential to life safety. | | | | | |
