	CURRENT SITUATION
Situation Summary:	Firefighters are faced with a strong Santa Ana wind event continuing into Friday evening. Approximately 574 firefighters are currently on-scene with additional resources responding from all over the state. Firefighters continue to battle this wind driven fire as it jumped the 14 freeway overnight. Current objectives include protecting structures and looking for opportunities to build containment lines. We continue to monitor the weather with single digit relative humidity daytime high temperatures into the 90's and recent wind increases with gusts up to 45mph in the area. The erratic winds today pose a challenge for our firefighters as they may change direction and intensify, posing a greater threat to homes. *Damage Assessment (DINS) arrived on the incident this morning and will have reports on numbers of structures Damaged and or Destroyed when assessments are
Evacuations	complete. Approx. 40,000 residents are currently under evacuation orders. County Fire and Sheriffs are working together to identify areas that can be repopulated safely.
