	CURRENT SITUATION
Situation Summary:	Currently, 509 firefighters remain on-scene with additional resources available should further need arise. Firefighters continue to perform spot checks throughout the burned areas to prevent any chance of rekindle with a change in the weather. Current objectives include looking for further opportunities to build containment lines and continuing to patrol the fire grounds identifying any potential risk of rekindle. We continue to monitor the weather and a Red Flag Warning will be in affect through this afternoon. Wind prone areas will see gusts between 40-50mph with sustained winds between 10-30mph throughout the day.
