CURRENT SITUATION						
Situation Summary:	Firefighters are faced with a strong Santa Ana wind this evening and into Friday. Approximately 500 firefighters are currently on-scene with additional resources responding from all over the state. Firefighters will maintain a tactical patrol throughout the evening, protecting structures and looking for opportunities to build containment lines. As the fire fight continues, we are monitoring the winds throughout the evening as they may increase or change direction & intensify this fire and destroy more homes.					
Evacuations/ Repopulations:	40,000 residents are currently under evacuation orders. Repopulation planning is ongoing. County Fire and Sheriffs are working together to identify areas that can be repopulated this evening safely.
