CURRENT SITUATION

Situation Summary:	Units will continue to patrol the burn area throughout today. Final acreage is 1,525 with 94% containment due to steep cliffs at fire edge making access for fire personnel extremely difficult. The fire has not moved in days and mapping of the fire has determined that the majority of hot spots have been cooled.
Evacuations:	All evacuation orders have been lifted as of 2 P.M. on 07/06/2020. Approximately 9 homes with 40 residents were repopulated today.
Temporary Evacuation Point(s):	**The Victory Outreach Evacuation Point was closed at 4 P.M. on 07/6/2020.** Victory Outreach 37419 25th Street E Palmdale, CA 93550
Road Closures:	**All roads have re-opened.**
