CURRENT SITUATION

Current Situation:	<p>For tonight, weak north to northeast winds are anticipated with gusts between 10 and 15 MPH. Despite the weak northeasterly winds, relative humidity recovery should be moderate to good. Firefighting resources will continue to mop up and patrol. Unburned interior islands as well as burned structures adjacent to control lines will be monitored to prevent spread. Crews remain diligent in providing public service to residents as they return to their homes. Structures destroyed and damaged have been validated by damage assessment teams.
