The **City of Gardena** and the **Los Angeles County Fire Department** are proud to host the Department's Community Emergency Response Training (CERT) program, developed in accordance with standards set by the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

After a major disaster, first responders may be inundated with emergency requests and demands. Residents may have to rely on each other for immediate first aid and life-sustaining needs. The Department's CERT program provides basic training in safety and life-saving skills.
