

Dear Property Owner:

Homes that may have been impacted by the Bridge, Franklin, Palisades, or Eaton fires. If your home was destroyed or damaged in one of these fires, we share our deepest condolences with you and your family.

We are still collecting damage inspection data on parcels affected by these fires. If you received the Annual Notice for the 2026 Defensible Space Inspection Program, and your home was destroyed or damaged greater than 25%, you will not be expected to pay fees or assessments associated with the 2025 or 2026 Defensible Space Inspection. You will also be removed from the inspection list for the 2026 inspection season and will not be added back to the program until you are able to rebuild and occupy your home.
